Did You Know? Federal & State Laws Are Being Violated Through Mail-Order Abortion Drugs



As you may know, chemical abortion using mifepristone and misoprostol is the most often used abortion method in the United States. The FDA approves this method for use during pregnancy up to 10 weeks gestation and North Carolina's law prohibits residents from mailing or receiving abortion pills in the mail. For the health and safety of the mother, an ultrasound is required per state law.

However, unregulated international online pharmacies are shipping abortion drugs to all 50 states—often *without requiring a prescription or medical consultation*. Many impose no gestational limits, creating **significant health risks** for women.

Plan C, an organization that supports such wide availability of these dangerous pills, lists several websites that *North Carolina residents can order the abortion pills from, including beyond the 10 week mark and for all ages*.

Federal enforcement is needed to prevent illegal abortion drug shipments from harming women and babies.

“This is not health care. Women deserve better than dangerous drugs sent through the mail with no medical oversight. Unborn children deserve protection, not starvation and death cloaked by the veneer of “medicine.” And the American people deserve honesty from federal agencies and politicians who claimed safety while ignoring mounting evidence of harms.
